Martino Colonna is an associated professor at University of Bologna where he has founded and direct the Sport Technology Lab that works in the development, design and testing of materials for sport equipment.

He is scientific coordinator of 4 LIFE projects on recycling of sport equipment and he is supervisor of 4 MSCA-DN PhD positions on sport shoes sustainability.

He is also founder of other two startups (O-DAMP and MOTORIALAB) active in the field of sport equipment and safety. He is author of 88 scientific papers on peer reviewed journals, of 3 books and 5 book chapters and of over 30 international patents.
